Incarceration at a glance

Of all counties in California in 2021, Glenn County has the **eighth highest** county jail incarceration rate.

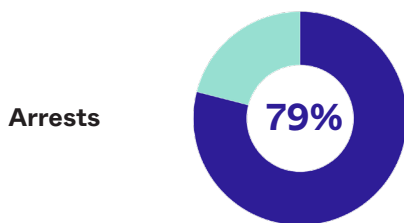
Glenn County has:

- 1 county jail
- 0 state prisons
- 0 juvenile facilities

On an average day in 2021, there were 73 people in county jails and 71 people from Glenn County in the state prison system.

In 2021, law enforcement agencies made 424 arrests and 1,326 county jail admissions, and courts sentenced 40 people to state prison.

Looking across the system

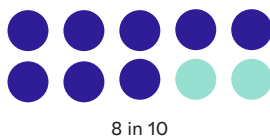


79 percent of all arrests in Glenn County in 2021 were for **misdemeanors**.

On any given day in 2021, the **Black arrest rate was 1.6 times** the arrest rate of white people.

Jails



83 percent of people in jail in Glenn are pretrial, meaning they **have not been convicted** of charges filed against them.

14%

14 percent of the jail population in Glenn County has **mental health needs**.

In 2021, Glenn County used 24% of its total general fund spending on the criminal legal system. That's \$18 million that could have been spent on the things proven to make communities safer: good schools, jobs, housing, and health care.

Within criminal legal system spending

45% goes to law enforcement (Sheriff)

37% goes to detention and probation

18% goes to judicial expenses
