On an average day in 2021, there were 680 people in county jails and 660 people from Sonoma County in the state prison system.

In 2021, law enforcement agencies made 10,331 arrests and 9,163 county jail admissions, and courts sentenced 208 people to state prison.




**75** percent of all arrests in Sonoma County in 2021 were for misdemeanors.


**68 percent of people** in jail in Sonoma are pretrial, meaning they **have not been convicted** of charges filed against them.

#### Sonoma County general fund spending, fiscal year 2021



In 2021, Sonoma County used 47% of its total general fund spending on the criminal legal system. That's \$245.2 million that could have been spent on the things proven to make communities safer: good schools, jobs, housing, and health care.
